DSP Rules & Regulations

- **Behavior:** Maintain good conduct, be courteous, speak in English, stay attentive, and keep the school clean. No bullying or misconduct inside or outside school.
- **Attendance:** 80% minimum attendance, no test rescheduling, absences over 3 days need permission, and no early leave allowed.
- **Uniform:** Wear a clean uniform, polished shoes, and maintain hygiene. Boys must have short hair; girls must tie hair in two plaits. No hair coloring, nail polish, or fancy jewelry.
- Watches allowed after Class 4.
- No mobile phones, expensive jewelry, inappropriate books, toys, inflammable, or sharp objects.
- Parents are required to inform the school authorities/class teacher if there is any change of address and telephone numbers (Important in case of emergency and we need to contact the parents)

Strict adherence is required; violations will result in disciplinary action.
